STRATTON'S GIRL stalked four wide, opened a clear advantage on the turn, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and was all out to hold off the runner-up. FIRST FLUTE relinquished the lead to the winner on the turn and fought back gamely along the rail in deep stretch. LOVELY PROMISE was outrun along the rail for a half, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. SHE'S SMOKIN HOT was outrun after breaking slowly, rallied four wide to reach contention in midstretch and flattened out. BELLA KARAKORUM checked after being pinched back at the start and raced wide thereafter. BADGETTE chased four wide to the turn and tired. BEST DECISION never reached contention after breaking slowly. PHONE JAZZ veered in causing crowding at the start, dueled between horses for a half and gave way.
