BENEATH THE CROWN stalked the leader from the outside while being mildly urged, responded positively when set down after turning for home, reached even terms with the leader with a sixteenth to go and proved best in the late stages under a drive. THE PLOT THICKENS well rated along the inside cutting the pace, was put to encouragement upon reaching the quarter pole, felt the top one's presence at the sixteenth pole, gamely offered resistance before grudgingly yielding the lead nearing the wire. QUIET ON THE TEE took the inside route while placed under a good hold, angled three wide nearing the head of the stretch to commence his rally, came home with good energy after being straightened away. TOBRUK well placed tracking the pacesetter from the pocket, lacked a solid stretch response when called upon. GAMBLIN FEVER within striking distance three wide, was forced into the four path by QUIET ON THE TEE heading for the stretch, weakened during the stretch run. BRUSHED PRINCE outrun for six furlongs, displayed late energy down the center of the course. RELATIVELY READY had a four wide journey and tired. SMART ENUF was no threat.
