### Footnotes

JUDGE WELL unhurried while racing well off the inside, commenced his rally when roused in upper stretch, steadily advanced towards the leader, then displaying a good late burst of energy, proved best a few jumps prior to the finish line. NEW YORK BOBBY stumbled at the start, was outrun for a half, unleashed a four wide sweep to enter contention during the run around the far bend, then continued on home with good courage to gain the place. NATIVE MAMBO was bumped at the start, chased the pacesetter from the outside, issued his challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, needed only a few strides to wrest command away, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, was outfinished during the final sixteenth. FAIR CATCH rode the rail, was briefly caught behind a tiring rival midway on the turn, squeezed his way between foes to escape that situation, lacked the necessary stretch response after being called upon. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB made the lead on his own courage from the two path after entering the turn, was gradually eased inward, met a stiff test turning for home, offered resistance for a few strides and weakened thereafter. MACHO MAMBO bobbed after being bumped at the start, tired after going a half. WINLOC'S BIG D hustled to the lead, gave way after going three furlongs. SMARTERALEX was outrun.
