BUY THE SPORT alternated for the early lead between horses, eased back a bit before going a half, settled just off the pace while three wide to the turn, swung four wide to launch her bid leaving the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track to get up in the final twenty yards. LADY TAK settled in good position while well off the rail along the backstretch, worked her way forward from outside on the far turn, charged to the front while four wide on the turn, extended her advantage in upper stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. SPOKEN FUR was reserved for five furlongs while saving ground, angled out on the far turn, circled five wide advancing into the stretch, closed the gap to threaten in midstretch then narrowly missed for the place. ISLAND FASHION raced just behind the pacesetter along the backstretch, lodged a mild bid between horses on the turn but couldn't sustain her rally. HOLIDAY LADY was bumped slightly in the early stages, angled wide along the backstretch, continued wide to the top of the stretch and failed to threaten while improving her position. STELLAR failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. ALCHEMIST up close early, dropped back before going a half then failed to menace while racing wide. DANUTA rushed up along the rail to gain the early advantage, set the pace along the inside to the turn then steadied sharply while giving way near the quarter pole.
