UNCLE SOUTHERN broke on top and remained on the lead, showed the way, well rated and with the runner up failing to make her presence felt at all times during the initial half, got asked for a response entering the stretch, made it through the furlong grounds with only a minimal loss of real estate, began to drift out slightly but steadily once past the furlong marker with the second place finisher closing in dangerously all the while, was kept going well enough to preserve the decision. AVE'S HALO put to a good hold by the pilot after the start, patiently accompanied the winner from the outside for the opening half, got set down for the stretch, closed in well belatedly, partially aided by the errant ways of the top one at this stage, fell short. DESERT BLISS raced from off the inside, commenced the stretch being three wide, rallied willingly en route for the show. SCRIBBLING SARAH bobbed slightly very shortly after brushing the right side of the starting gate, sat in midpack chasing from the two path on the turn, got set down for the drive home, altered course to the outside in the vicinity of three-sixteenths marker, drifted back into the two path right afterwards after being a steady diet of right handed stick work, finished fairly evenly during the last eighth. POP POP'S SMYLE was put to mild hand urging soon after the start to keep pace with the front runners, tucked along the rail just past the half mile pole and rode it for the next quarter, got put to strong encouragement angling outward turning for home, came up empty. FANTASTIC EYES was no factor off a ground-saving journey. BONATINI saved ground on the turn and tired.
