RAGING DAOUST, fidgety in the stall awaiting the gate being sprung open, lunged when the field was finally sent on its way, assumed a forward position after the start, sat perched in the three path behind the fighting front runners for a good portion down the backstretch and during the initial stages of the run around the bend as well, crept steadily into contention leaving the midway point, poked a head down in front spinning into the lane, being encouraged the lightest of the trio at this juncture, fought tenaciously with TALK THERAPY during the ensuing furlong but was unable to shake completely free, began to kick away after going a few additional strides and stayed in the clear, kept to the task at hand. TALK THERAPY along the inside, argued for command with ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS, always the more asked of the twosome, had the winner arrive on the scene and increase the pressure dramatically shortly before arriving at the end of the bend, got set down soon afterwards, fought with distinction travelling through the furlong grounds, but wasn't able to claim the advantage, held on in a willing manner to the end to secure second. ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS disputed the pace from the outside, was between rivals challenging for the lead as the field turned for home, remained in the thick of things for another furlong before weakening. DRINK WITH PRIDE broke inward a couple of steps, tracked the ongoing pace dispute from the pocket put to some hand urging on the bend, came up empty for the stretch run. SACRED GROUND off to a sluggish start, raced near the inside for the opening three-quarters, failed to menace. GIANT INDIAN gave chase from the two path, was put to a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, tired. DIGHTON well out towards the middle of the strip proceeding down the backstretch, departed it three wide, drifted slightly wider entering the lane, made no impact at any time.
