Footnotes

BIKINI BEAUTY saved ground in the early going, got tipped into the three path midway around the bend, was given her cue and responded positively, paused prior to altering course coming to the end of the furlong grounds, kicked into full gear after completing the maneuver, roared by the second place finisher and drew well clear. MOBILIZE gave chase towards the two path, although at times a bit wider on the turn, got set down for the stretch and struck the front, proved powerless when tackled by the winner, finished well to secure second. HOLABIRD three to four wide on the turn, rallied willingly for the show. SHY SOCIETY closed in on the front runners racing three wide on the turn, challenged for the lead heading into the stretch, flattened out. ACQUANT mostly two wide and between rivals racing on the turn, lacked the needed response. WONDERFULLY WILD forwardly placed from the two path, tired in the final furlong. MISS SUPER QUICK three wide heading for the end of the backstretch, disputed the pace primarily two wide on the turn, grabbed a slim advantage between calls after completing a half, got set down for the stretch and was hooked up with the runner up, fell back slightly as the pair made their way through the furlong grounds and steadily weakened thereafter. FROM TIZ MOMENT ON a forward factor along the inside during the initial stages, faltered. TAPITBYTHESEA broke out slightly leaving the starting gate, rode the rail until the quarter pole, was kept on hold waiting for better racing room

from close proximity to that station until upper stretch, gained the needed room and failed to fire appreciably when finally called upon. CRASHING CONCLAVE raced along the outside and was outrun. SUNSET RIDE was grabbed hold and pulled towards the outside after taking the initial step sharply inward, raced sluggishly down the backstretch, was along the outside on the turn and was outrun. SAMURAI'S HONOR argued for command from the inside on the turn, retreated readily once displaced on the front end.
