HUMDINGER came away in good order, raced with the pace from the outside while well in hand, took over when asked for run, drew clear into the stretch and remained well clear while being kept to the business at hand. FESTIVAL HALL was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and rallied outside to get the place. HARLANQUIN was rated along early, raced between rivals and offered a mild rally while between rivals in the stretch. WAR STORM raced in hand outside, was wide on both turns and was outfinished. FLY WITH THE WIND chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. ACE ON THE RIVER was outrun early, raced between rivals and lacked a rally. GOOD LOOKING OUT chased the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. PARA RIDER had no response when roused. ALL PLAY dropped back early, raced inside on the turn, altered course to the outside in the stretch and had no rally. REALLY REILLY was outrun along the inside. READY READ was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. NOMORESURPRISES was pulled up on the backstretch and was vanned off.
