BLUE CREEK four wide entering the turn, was fanned seven wide exiting it, got straightened away and gained ground readily from upper to midstretch, maintained the momentum, was the outermost of four arriving at nearly the same time at the sixteenth pole, outkicked them all and edged away, crossing the wire under hand urging. CREA'S LAW traded a series of light bumps with TERMINUS while about midway down the backstretch, rode the rail for the opening half, was taken outward and continued to angle towards the middle of the track until in the three path more than midway through the furlong grounds, almost had the advantage at the sixteenth marker but lost out on the honor when the winner got there first, dug in stubbornly to grab the place. TERMINUS leaned upon the runner up then went on to trade several bumps with the same opponent while racing down the backstretch, raced two wide around the turn, although appearing to have intentions of ducking inward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, fought his way to the front while battling with another pair from the three-sixteenths pole to the furlong marker, maintained a slim lead for about a sixteenth, got overtaken then weakened steadily into the show slot. MY MAN DAN bobbled slightly at the break, steadily improved position during the opening half, flattened out a bit after entering the stretch. GREY FOOSE launched a rail move when ready to take over from ICE THEATER leaving the half mile pole, remained under a good hold until the quarter pole, vied with a pair from the three-sixteenths pole until mid lane, relinquished and gave way. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE raced from between

horses on the turn, was gradually taken outward after turning for home, squeezed his way into the four path at the eighth pole, but soon flattened out. WHY BROADWAY off the inside, was taken hold when slightly bothered WARRIOR FROM ABOVE coming to the eighth pole. HOW DO I WIN chased three wide and had no kick. TYCOON CAT out a step at the break, failed to menace. KELTIC FIGHTER four wide departing the backstretch, folded. ICE THEATER displayed brief speed from the two path and faltered.
