SEAN AVERY away well, settled just off the pace placed in the three path around the turn, came under encouragement cornering four wide for home, seized command at the sixteenth marker, edged away under a drive to prevail. ZERO RATE POLICY hustled from the gate initially to be forwardly placed, was taken back off the pace at the five-eighths pole as CROSSBOW and ROYAL CURRIER commenced their challenges for command, settled at the rear while two to three wide in the turn unhurried and losing ground, came under urging at the quarter pole, angled out in the vicinity of the eighth pole to the center of the course, displayed a good late kick to just procure the place honors on the line in the last jump. ROYAL CURRIER prompted the pace while two to three wide in the turn, came under a ride at the quarter pole, seized command with an eighth to go, got collared a sixteenth down the stretch kicking on mildly, then was outfinished late on and forced to settle for the show. CROSSBOW challenged for the lead at the five-eighths and was conceded the front at that station, set the pace from just off the inside while prompted by ROYAL CURRIER throughout, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, maintained his lead under rousing before succumbing the front at the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages.
