Footnotes

WHY NOT WHISKEY bumped by DREAMSGONEWILD when that rival broke inwards, got squeezed back between rivals and was briefly in hand at the start, raced from just off the inside towards the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide in upper stretch let out, offered up a good kick through the stretch moving into prominence with an eighth to go, closed fast through the final furlong getting up in the last strides to prove best. LORD OF LOVE three wide in close range of the front, came under a drive at the quarter pole, seized command nearing the eighth pole, edged away, kept on erratically in the stretch shying inwards and outwards opposite of the stick work being applied by the rider, got caught in the final strides being forced to settle for the place honors. RIVER TUNE broke out at the start bumping RIVERDANCE ROCK before being corrected, squeezing both that rival and WHY NOT WHISKEY in tandem with DREAMSGONEWILD who broke inwards, sat reserved in midpack just off the inside from the two path until placed to coaxing at the three-eighths, got set down spinning inside for home, kicked home with late energy to garner the show. PAPA TOM five wide throughout in midpack initially, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung six wide into the stretch, kicked home belatedly outside for the last major share. SOLENGO tracked the pace down along the inside, got set down cutting the corner into the lane making mild headway on the front, remained in contention to the sixteenth marker before weakening late on. TOWER IN COURT four to five wide towards the rear, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole, cornered five wide at the quarter pole, bumped with PALACE nearing the finish lightly while passing tired rivals in the stretch. WINNING PAL set the pace from the two path, came under a ride at the quarter pole, succumbed the front nearing the final furlong and faltered in the final furlong. T C H WARRIOR raced three to four wide towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and made no impact. RIVERDANCE ROCK bumped and squeezed back at the break, raced four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement and made mild progress from the five-sixteenths to

the top of the stretch before weakening in the lane. DREAMSGONEWILD broke in at the start bumping and squeezing out WHY NOT WHISKEY and RIVERDANCE ROCK in tandem with RIVER TUNE, chased just off the pace while three to four wide through the turn, got called upon at the five-sixteenths and tired. PALACE hit the near side stall at the start getting off a beat slow as a result, chased three wide in midpack, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, angled out for a clear lane late on, got bumped lightly by TOWER IN COURT just nearing the finish while tiring and fell heavily just yards from home, was apprehended by the outrider and subsequently walked off under his own power. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run regarding the fallen PALACE before the result was declared official.
