**Footnotes**

TOP YANK set the pace from the two path under some pressure to his outside, cut the corner into the lane roused, edged away through the stretch being kept to task to the line. BLACK ACE prompted the pace from the three path, came under a drive swinging for home offering up a mild kick, proved no match when unable to reel in the top one, remained clear under a drive for the place safely second best. DOUBLESPEAK four wide towards the rear, cut the corner into the stretch under a ride, kicked home with good energy belatedly to procure the show, drifted out late on at the wire under left handed stick work. KATHY'S KITTEN two to three wide in close pursuit, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, remained in contention until the final furlong before

weakening in the late stages. RENZO BERTONI bumped at the start by EL CORRIENTE when that rival broke outwards, raced along midpack while two to three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun six wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild bid gaining some ground late on while unable to threaten the top. ALL ZIPPED UP tracked the pace down along the inside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three wide at the quarter pole, got out kicked through the lane. EL CORRIENTE broke out at the start bumping RENZO BERTONI before being corrected, chased from towards rear just off the inside in the two path, got let out at the five-sixteenths, passed tired rivals in the lane. SHOUTOUT four to five wide in midpack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and made no impact. LOGICAL ORDER just off the pace chasing three to four wide, got asked at the five-sixteenths and tired in the stretch. TENNIS RACKET chased three wide from midpack, got set down at the five-sixteenths and tired. ORCHESTRA LEADER three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole and never factored. QUIET EYES steadied briefly at the start, raced from towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and never reached contention.
