CRITICAL EYE was rated outside while within striking distance early, advanced three wide on the turn, dug in gamely when set down for the drive and prevailed after a long drive. PLENTY OF LIGHT quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely on the rail through the stretch. RESORT was outrun early, rallied inside on the turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. ATELIER showed good speed from the outside, chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. NORTH LAKE JANE chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and tired. SECRET STATUS dropped back after the start and had no response when roused. A. O. L. HAYES chased the pace while between rivals and tired after three quarters. TRIP chased the pace on the backstretch and was finished early.
