NOBIZ LIKE SHOBIZ raced close up outside while well in hand, angled to the inside and advanced quickly approaching the stretch, came through on the rail turning for home, quickly drew away and widened on his own courage, winning as his rider pleased. BULLARA contested the pace while three wide, had no answer when the winner ran by and was easily best of the others. JEDOUM was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. PROFITEER raced greenly along the inside and had no rally. VANQUISHER veered to the inside after the start and raced very greenly. LIBERTARIAN broke to the inside, was hustled up between rivals, contested the pace and tired. PINK VIPER raced wide throughout and tired. COUNTY CLERK raced close up along the inside, chased the pace for a half mile and tired. GOWDEN MILE showed speed along the inside, contested the pace and was finished after a half mile.
