The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weight for age. Three year olds, 121 lbs.; older, 126 lbs. The New York Racing Association to add the Man o'War Bowl to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. The owner of the winner will also receive a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 26, 2006 with 18 Nominations.

Footnotes

CACIQUE (IRE) raced in hand early while between rivals, found room along the inside entering the stretch, accelerated quickly when asked, reached the front nearing the eighth pole and drew clear late under a drive. GO DEPUTY was rated along early, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in gamely outside in the drive and was up for the place. SHOWING UP prompted the pace from the outside while well in hand, earned a short lead between calls in upper stretch, could not handle the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for the place. COSMONAUT raced close up outside while in hand, was three wide on both turns and faded in the final furlong. RELAXED GESTURE (IRE) was taken back after the start, was rated along inside, came wide entering the stretch and finished well outside. CROWN POINT raced close up while saving ground, was steadied along the inside turning for home and tired in the drive. RAMAZUTTI was urged to the front, set the pace along the inside while in hand and gave way nearing the stretch.
