Footnotes

TOASTING was unhurried from off the inside while well within range, got let out a notch during the later stages of the run around the bend, was placed in three path at the five-sixteenths pole gearing up for the stretch, turned for home one lane wider and was asked for a response, gave it, cutting readily into the runner up's margin from upper to midstretch, drew even with about a sixteenth to go and edged away, crossing the wire hand urged. GIRL CODE contently tracked the leader while taking the inside route, found room to slip outward once INDY'S MAGIC MONEY resumed her errant ways near the five-sixteenths pole, made a successful challenge a little further down the road to the lead the field into the stretch, tried but couldn't shake loose for good, had the advantage taken away with just under a sixteenth remaining, but had no trouble though staying well clear of the others for the place. SQUEAL took an awkward step ducking inward at the start, raced from off the rail, was asked for run past the midway point on the turn, rallied well enough to finish as a non-threatening third. FORM FITTING forwardly placed while saving ground, remained so for nearly three-quarters, vied with INDY'S MAGIC MONEY around the turn and took over after negotiating halfway around it, got put to a stern test by the second place finisher just before reaching the quarter pole, yielded without any real resistance and tired. INDY'S MAGIC MONEY broke on top, was the leader until about the three-eighths pole, was getting out badly proceeding down the backstretch, with at one time a sizeable amount of lanes separating her from the rest, managed to stay put in the two path for most of the way around the turn before getting out once again near the end of it, drifted out badly throughout the stretch while backing away. WATRUGONNADOROSIE slow to settle into stride, was always far back.
