Footnotes

OVEREXTENDED raced from off the inside, was let out a notch coming to the end of the backstretch, went on a little further before beginning to pick up the pace, was taken outward and placed three wide at the midway point once MONEY IN MOTION before to drop back, ranged up towards the leader and poked a head down in front as the pair spun into the stretch, shook free during the ensuing furlong, went on to extend the margin, finishing under hand encouragement. RUTHERFORD B. bumped with GOOD LAW after bobbling at the start, quickly established control and was sent over to the inside, proved ratable while cutting the pace on an open advantage, had no answer when the winner made his presence felt late on the turn, yielding readily, remained well clear of the others however for place honors. HURRICANE HEAT coaxed along while tracking the pacesetter from the rail, saved ground until the quarter pole, got called upon after angling outward for the stretch run, proved no match. PRIME PLAYER tucked along the rail about midway down the backstretch, was set to a drive by the three-eighths pole, got angled to the outside, eventually taking the three path for entrance into the lane, made no real headway. GOOD LAW made contact with the runner up at the start, loosely stalked the pacesetter from the outside for almost six furlongs and folded. MONEY IN MOTION three wide departing the backstretch, was momentarily wider still once the winner launched his move from the three-eighths pole, tired. LINCOLN PENNY three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting it, failed to threaten.
