CATCH UP CHRIS away in good order, quickly established command, showed the way on an open lead, emerged from the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, then needed strong encouragement to last. ESTIMATOR bided his time while racing along the outside, swung outward in upper stretch, had a good late rally. AT ATTENTION unhurried for a half, entered four wide into the lane and came home willingly. CHARING CROSS chased the pacesetter while racing wide for a half and weakened. PAPA JERRY took the inside route, made a mild bid to reach contention by the furlong marker, flattened out. VALIANT HUMOR stumbled at the start, raced well placed along the outside until the quarter pole, was asked for a response but came up empty. TOMLINSON HILL raced three wide, steadily tired after going a half. BOBCAT BRODY saved ground to no avail.
