MISSILE MOTOR took the overland route around the bend, was asked for some run as early as the seven-sixteenths pole, steadily advanced into a contending position despite being the widest of all during the run around the turn, spun while still the widest of the front runners into the lane, closed in gradually during the ensuing furlong, wore down CALLMETONY to earn the decision. CALLMETONY gave chase departing the backstretch four wide, moved up to bid in earnest late on the turn, overhauled the leader to take over, but with the top one in close proximity, relinquished past the eighth pole, but was kept going to be well clear of the others for the place. SCORCH THE TORCH got outstuffed leaving the gate, took the inside route on the turn, was put to encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, altered course off the rail approaching the eighth pole and rallied mildly to finish a non-threatening third. DIGGER KARAKORUM argued for the lead from the two path, gave way after turning for home. AL'S LARK was continuously trying to get out on the turn, got placed to right handed stick work and a strong grip on the left rein by the rider attempting to correct this tendency, came up firing blanks for the stretch drive. MR. HADIF was never involved. LEAP DAY off a beat slowly, loped along at the back of the pack off the inside, was always outrun. THE ZIPSTER received a series of five choppy shots from the stick on the right shoulder after the gate was sprung open, disputed the pace three wide for about a half before backing away.
