**Footnotes**

TAKE A WALK chose the overland route for the run around the bend, ranged up dangerously approaching the quarter pole, made a successful five wide challenge for command upon reaching that station, got straightened away and was placed to a vigorous hand ride, kicked clear of the competition drawing off to a comfortable advantage, was geared down confidently for the final sixteenth. GROUNDED LOVE gave chase three wide, was taken over to a clear passageway down along the rail in upper stretch, made his way down the lane under a strong drive and held on for the place. JEANBAPTISTE COROT bumped with ALLEN'S AFFAIR at the start, raced off the inside, as did the others for most of the running of the event, closed in gradually on the second place finisher late, but came up short. MAKE MY MOVE under a four wide pursuit, moved up to intensify the pressure on the leader late on the turn, failed to sustain the move after entering the stretch. BLACK DIABLO ducked in after bobbling at the break, was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest opponent before any significant contact could be made, got taken in hand a second time prior to being eased to the outside to allow an escape route for the rival in distress shortly before completing the opening quarter, raced off the rail thereafter and was through after completing three-quarters. ALLEN'S AFFAIR got turned slightly sideways after being bumped near the hind quarters at the start, moved up to assume a forward position, vied for the lead from the two path, with a couple of the others applying honest pressure, came under assault nearing the quarter pole and succumbed. PAYOUT went inward after stumbling badly at the start, was taken hold and put back on course, rushed up without need of much urging to take up a forward position, began to lose action while vying for command down along the rail coming to the three-quarters pole, eased back under a firm hold and got pulled up, was subsequently vanned off.
