INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any point prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Dirt weights, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt in 10-11 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over on the dirt in 2011 allowed 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt allowance weights will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 27, 2011 with 20 Nominations.

Footnotes

GRASSY patiently stalked the pacesetter while undergoing a three journey, moved up to improve position coming to the quarter pole, turned for home simultaneously called upon, cut into the leader's margin during the next eighth, forged on ahead, took over for good in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, had opened up a good length lead when wrapped up for the final strides. CENTER DIVIDER placed under a firm hold took up the role of stalker soon after the start, sat just to the outside of SAL THE BARBER along the outside, remained unhurried until approaching the quarter pole, was set down as the stretch battle commenced, fought his way to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, proved no match when the eventual winner arrived on the scene a sixteenth down the road, yielded readily to that opponent, dug in with good determination to preserve the place. BOLD HAWK four wide into the stretch, displayed a good kick down the center of the course en route for the show. SANAGAS (GER) judiciously took the inside route around the opening bend, swung off the rail entering the backstretch and remained along the outside thereafter, came home willingly to earn the final major share of the purse. KINDERGARDEN KID tracked the pacesetter from the inside, with the rider aboard with a firm hold on the reins, lacked the necessary stretch response. COLONIALISM settled along the inside shortly before reaching the first turn, slipped outward midpoint on the far turn, spun wide into the stretch and got asked for a response, refused to angle outward at several junctures during the stretch drive, stubbornly resisting several tugs on the right side of the rein as well as left handed stick work. SAL THE BARBER broke on the top, was immediately put to a snug hold leading the competition to the first turn, was let out a notch coming to the five-sixteenths pole and asked for still more run a short distance later, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away.
