FINAL PROPOSAL contested the pace while between rivals and continued on gamely to hold the place. FLAMINGO WAY, outrun early, offered a mild rally along the inside. ANKLET contested the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. GOLD PRINCESS contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. HURRICANE BERTIE contested the pace while five wide and tired in the stretch. MICH'S PITCH was outrun.
