SILVERBULLETDAY ducked in after the start, was taken in hand and angled off the inside on the backstretch, raced close up while three wide on the turn, responded when asked, quickly drew clear and was kept to a drive to the finish. QUEEN'S WORD, outrun early, advanced outside on the turn and finished gamely. AWFUL SMART showed in front while well in hand, ducked out on the backstretch, contested the pace while between rivals and stayed on stubbornly to the wire. GOLD FROM THE WEST, between rivals early while in hand, was roused on the rail on the turn and stayed on well inside through the stretch. COUNTRY HIDEAWAY raced close up inside while in hand, slipped through along the rail to take a short lead leaving the backstretch then tired in the drive. SINGING ROCKETTE raced close up outside, was steadied as AWFUL SMART ducked out on the backstretch then dropped back and tired badly.
