SHAKE YOU DOWN came away in good order and flashed sharp speed from the outside, opened a clear lead soon after entering the turn, cruised away turning for home and remained comfortably clear under a hand ride. PAPUA was outrun early, raced three wide and finished well outside to earn the place award. SUPER FUSE raced between rivals early on, rallied inside entering the stretch and was outfinished for the place spot. PINCH HITTER was outrun along the inside early, altered course to the outside in the stretch and lacked a rally. SPEED HUNTER was hustled along inside and had no response when roused. HOOK AND LADDER showed speed along the inside and was finished early.
