GHOSTZAPPER argued the pace while between rivals, was carried out into the stretch, bumped with SAINT LIAM in the drive and bested that rival after a prolonged battle. SAINT LIAM contested the pace along the inside, drifted out entering the stretch, bumped with the winner in the drive and dug in gamely to the wire. BOWMAN'S BAND was bumped at the start, raced in hand outside, angled in into the turn, put in a run along the rail nearing the stretch and had nothing left for the drive. SEEK GOLD was crowded at the start, was hustled along to keep up early, raced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. NEWFOUNDLAND was hustled along outside, raced wide and tired in the stretch. MIDWAY ROAD raced close up inside early, had no response when roused and tired. PRESIDENTIALAFFAIR, bumped at the start, contested the pace while three wide and tired after a half mile.
