STAKES Man o' War S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

WIDENER TURF (UP TO \$55,000 NYSBFOA) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weight for age. Three year olds, 121 lbs.; older, 126 lbs. The New York Racing Association to add the Man o'War Bowl to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. The owner of the winner will also receive a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 28, 2004 with 24 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.)

Footnotes

MAGISTRETTI was taken back after the start, was rated along, raced inside on the second turn, swung to the outside turning for home, responded when asked for run, finished with a rush from the outside and was clear under the wire. EPALO (GER) quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, drew away when roused in upper stretch, took a clear lead into deep stretch and stayed on gamely but could not withstand the winner late. KING'S DRAMA (IRE) raced with the pace from the outside while in hand and stayed on well in the stretch. BETTER TALK NOW was outrun early, moved into contention with a four wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. REQUEST FOR PAROLE was rated along early, advanced between rivals on the second turn and lacked a rally. BALLINGARRY (IRE) was rated along inside, saved ground and had no response when roused. BALTO STAR raced with the pace from the outside, was three wide on both turns and tired in the stretch. GREEK SUN raced in hand while three wide and tired in the stretch.
