SILVER TRAIN broke running, quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside while in hand, drew away when asked for run in upper stretch and was kept to the task to the finish. HIGH FLY raced close up outside while in hand, rallied three wide on the turn, took a run at the winner in upper stretch but was no match for that rival then continued on to hold the place. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was outrun early, raced three wide and finished well outside. SIR GREELEY showed good speed while in hand, chased the pace around the turn and tired in the stretch. BETTER THAN BONDS was in hand early on, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. AWESOME TWIST was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused.
