Footnotes

FIERY REBEL away from the starting in good order, was placed under a strong hold after assuming a forward position, sparred with ALWAYS ON THE MOVE before shaking free nearing the half mile, lengthened out to a comfortable advantage during the run around the bend, still not being asked for run, responded well when given his cue after turning for home, then maintained a safe winning margin while being kept to the end. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE was urged along while taking the inside route, was put back on hold just off a rival's heels coming to the three-eighths pole, found room to maneuver outward a sixteenth later, angled sharply four wide into the lane, took off after the leader, closing with good energy down the center of the strip en route for the place. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK unhurried during the early stages while racing along the inside, advanced when ready from midway on the turn, briefly waited behind a bit of traffic as the field headed for the quarter pole,angled outward soon after settling into upper stretch, rallied mildly to grab the show. SHOTGUN BANDIT saved ground until angled three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for a response soon afterwards, but lacked the necessary stretch response. ALWAYS ON THE MOVE vied for the lead from the two path for nearly six furlongs and gave way. RETAKE raced three wide and failed to reach a contending position. ECRU EGRET sluggish early, was never a menace. RETRIEVER forwardly placed while four wide around the turn, folded. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB raced along the outside and tired after completing three-quarters. GOLD CUP KID underwent a three wide pursuit, was through after going a half, then was eased after turning for home.
