HIGH PRIZE within striking distance three wide, was set down turning for home, closed relentlessly down the center of the course to earn the decision in the final jump. REAL ROOSTER chased the leader from the get go, being lightly coaxed along, was put to stronger encouragement nearing the top of the lane, wrested command briefly leaving the sixteenth pole, dug in trying to cling to a narrow edge, but was nailed right at the finish line. MR. HADIF took charge soon after the start, showed the way towards the inside, facing some pressure from REAL ROOSTER all the while, was wore down in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, steadily weakening thereafter. PEYTONS HEART raced along the outside and came home willingly. KING PRADA was hustled from the starting gate, rode the rail, was put to a prolonged drive, angled outward in upper stretch but failed to make any significant headway on the front runners. DIXIELORE was successfully guided over to the inside by the half mile pole, tracked the leader from the pocket under a firm hold, had a clear alleyway

along the inside turning for home, but failed to deliver a strong response. ALWAYS FISHIN raced along the outside and had no rally. BEIJING BLUES (ARG) three to four wide around the turn, weakened. EX PAT broke awkwardly, took the three path around the turn, and was never a factor. JAYBURGER off a beat slowly, was outrun. MAKE IT SPECIAL hustled away from the starting gate, offered little. D'SLEWSTER lunged at the break, was quickly swung over to the rail, saved ground during the remained of the runner and faltered.
