Footnotes

MR. ENRICO contently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, with the rider applying rating tactics until the quarter pole, was let out departing that station and kicked clear, held sway, driving. SKY BLUE PINK swerved out suddenly a few jumps out of the starting gate, bumping with RUNAWAY JIM and causing the rider of ROCKY F to steady his mount to avoid making serious contact, sat reserved near the back of the pack, was placed in the four path midway on the far turn, launched a run to narrow in on the front runners, loosely drafting behind ROCKY F, continued to follow that opponent before being tipped outward an additional path coming to the three-sixteenths pole, closed well en route to being second best. BISHOP OF NOLA worked his way to the front soon after the start, was rated along the inside for nearly three-quarters, dropped back when unable to keep pace with the winner after turning for home and steadily tired thereafter. ROCKY F steadied early on the opening bend, narrowly missing making solid contact with another pair, swung from the three path into the backstretch, sat reserved until nearing the half mile pole, made a four wide sweep to reach a good striking position by the five-sixteenths pole, could not sustain the move and flattened out. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA improved position by mainly weak and tired ones in the stretch. RUNAWAY JIM lunged at the break, bumped soundly with the runner up soon afterwards, remained unhurried in midpack off the inside, raced three wide around the far turn, lacked a rally. ZIP QUIK tossed his head to the right just before the gate was sprung open, bobbling as a result, settled into pocket, tracked the leader from there, lightly coaxed along, failed to fire when called upon for the stretch drive.
