BUFFUM gradually worked his way towards the front, while offering some resistance on the bit all the while, was placed into the two path and argued for command with BOLD WARRIOR, drifted outward approaching the head of the stretch, bumping lightly twice with and forcing the aforementioned foe to turn for home in the four path, was put to a steady diet of left handed stick work, came outward again, this time in the vicinity of the eighth pole, herding the runner up several paths outward, edged away from that point to cross the wire first. BOLD WARRIOR disputed the pace three wide for most of the way down the backstretch and during the run around the bend, was carried outward by the unofficial winner spinning into the lane, making some contact twice before reaching the three-sixteenths pole, forged on ahead, was impeded once more by BUFFUM and carried out at least two paths as the embattled front twosome neared the furlong marker, lost contact after that incident, but dug in gamely to fend off GOLDEN GULCH. GOLDEN GULCH guided over to the inside at the half mile pole, had a rail run that came up short for the place. ZIMMER four wide departing the backstretch, folded. ALMIGHTY SILVER swung five wide into upper stretch, had no response. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on BUFFUM during the stretch run, BUFFUM was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference.
