RICHMOND COUNTY vied for the lead three wide, was let out coming to the quarter pole, extended the margin during the ensuing furlong, left the eighth pole holding his biggest advantage and held sway, crossing the finish line under hand encouragement. SILVER MAX underwent a four wide pursuit, displayed good courage to stave off APSE for the place. APSE left the three-eighths pole four wide and got asked for a response, was eventually driven from the five path into the stretch, came home with good energy to secure the show. INDY SEA took up the chase from the two path, rallied mildly en route for the final major check. COZZETTI raced between rivals for much of the way around the turn, went on to improve position. GET RIGHT advanced willingly into midpack under light hand urging, swung to be six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. FLY RIDE coaxed along tracking the front runners from the inside, came up for the stretch drive. QUARTERMAIN vied from off the inside and faltered. TRADE took the inside route, was angled outward leaving the turn, proceeded down the lane, occasionally feeling and being flashed the whip from the right side. TIME LORD brushed the left side of the starting gate, was placed six wide at the top of the lane, had no rally. PARTY IN THE SUN departed the backstretch four wide, tired. THURSBY got off a beat slowly after striking the left of the gate soundly, raced three wide on the turn in a trailing effort.
