**Footnotes**

CHASING MOONLIGHT got away a bit slowly, taken in hand as rivals crossed over in front, picked up interest and closed in after going halfway around the bend, challenged for command as the widest of three front runners spinning into the lane, forged his way to the front before completing the next furlong, then edged away, kept to a drive. REAL ESTATE contested the pace from the outside, was between rivals entering the stretch, failed to keep up with the winner, salvaged second. HE'S SO CHIC lunged taking his initial step out of the starting gate, raced from off the inside, mostly two wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied belatedly, just falling short of garnering the place. LUXURY APPEAL argued to maintain a slim advantage being pressed by the second place finisher, kept at a slight distance from off the inside, had the pressure intensify when the winner arrived on the scene with a few strides remaining during the run around the bend, yielded for good travelling through the furlong grounds and steadily faltered thereafter. BUCKEYE HEART three wide on the turn, was slightly wider by the head of the stretch, had no rally. SENSATIONAL SLAM chased the ongoing pace dispute from the two path and gave way. HE AIN'T BLUFFING tired off a ground-saving journey.
