Footnotes

ADCAT, rated along early, split rivals while rallying on the second turn, came wide into the stretch, reached the front in midstretch then drew clear under a drive. YORK HARBOR, taken back, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished gamely to get the place. SENOR BUNDLE set the pace while in hand and weakened in the late stages. THUNDEROUS OVATION was hustled from the outside, throttled on the first turn, chased the pace from the outside then stayed on well while between rivals in the stretch. CARO'S BID, taken back early, rallied four wide on the second turn but offered only a mild finish in the stretch. IMPERIAL ROGER chased the pace and tired. JOKERS FRANGRANCE, rated along inside, had no response. BORGES DREAM tired after an inside trip. DEMAND BETTER raced five wide on the first turn, put in a three wide move on the second turn and tired. CHRIS'S CONQUEST, rated along early, raced five wide on the second turn and lacked a rally. BE ACCOUNTABLE tired after showing brief speed. DOCTOR ED was outrun.
