DAYLAMII, rated along early, was asked for run on the second turn, came wide for the drive, settled suddenly in midstretch and finished fast from the outside to be clear under the wire. BUCK'S BOY raced with the pace while under stout restraint, took the lead nearing the eighth pole, was briefly clear in deep stretch but could not handle the winner's late rush. INDY VIDUAL was hustled to the front, set the pace while in hand and stayed on gamely to the finish. LAZY LODI raced just behind the pacesetters while under wraps, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. HONOR GLIDE chased the pace from the outside and faded in the stretch. PANAMA CITY, rated along inside, raced wide on the second turn and lacked a rally. UNITE'S BIG RED, rated outside, put in a wide run into the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. ACCELERATOR was taken up to avoid the spill on the second turn then was eased through the stretch. CETEWAYO raced inside, stumbled and fell into the hedge nearing the quarter pole.
