SHINE AGAIN, close up inside while in hand, found room in upper stretch and finished gamely. FRENCH MADAM, bumped soundly at the start, raced inside on the turn, came wide for the drive, bumped with SARAH'S WORLD in upper stretch and finished gamely. SEARCH PARTY, bumped soundly at the start, raced wide and lacked a rally. SARAH'S WORLD, bumped soundly at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, bumped with FRENCH MADAM in upper stretch and tired. DEVIL'S FIDDLER, roughed up at the start, chased outside and tired. PERCHED HIGH raced inside and lacked a rally.
