Footnotes

SMILING BOB just off the pace from the two path, got set down swinging three wide for home, seized command at the eighth pole as BAJAN RHYTHM burst through a seam between foes, dueled head to head through the final furlong with that foe gamely to prevail on the line. BAJAN RHYTHM hit the off side stall at the start, raced a bit green when in and among rivals early on, steadily crossed to track inside from close range, was on hold nearing the quarter pole forced to await a seam in behind traffic with little option to angle out as rivals closed that path down straightening away, had a rival drift slightly under left handed stick work in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths, burst through the open seam a furlong out, hooked up in a spirited tussle with the aforementioned rival through the final eighth, got denied on the line while clear of the rest in a game effort. BIG FOOT BEN three wide in midpack, came under rousing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. HARD ENOUGH three wide in close range pursuing the front, came under urging at the three-eighths, spun from the two path into the lane, shied out slightly under near sided stick work at the three-sixteenths, remained prominent until the final eighth before weakening late on while garnering the last major share. DENN PIPER chased from midpack while two to three wide throughout, got called upon at the five-sixteenths and lacked a late kick. LASTING IMPACT outrun early on while racing a bit green displaying some climbing action, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide for home, passed tired rivals through the lane keeping on more professionally through the stretch. CANDY RAIDER three wide towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide for home, offered no kick. JEB'S BREW towards the rear just off the inside, got set down at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home and offered no response. HUGGY BOY away alertly, set a solid pace just off the inside in the two path, opted to the rail at the three-eighths pole, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, remained in contention to the three-sixteenths before giving way.
