OPEN SESAME showed good speed along the inside, raced with the pace, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. QUIET MIKE stumbled badly at the start, split rivals while advancing on the turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. FAJARDO broke awkwardly, raced close up while in hand, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and faded in the drive. COUNTRY BE GOLD came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. BE MINE TONIGHT put in a run along the inside on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. GHOST STORY came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SENOR FIZZ chased inside and tired in the stretch. CANFIELD tired after three quarters. VICTORIOUS RECALL contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. WHY SO QUIET stopped after showing brief speed and was eased in the stretch.
