### Footnotes

MUSIC NOTE broke through the gate prior to the start, stalked the leaders while four wide along the backstretch, moved up under her own power to take charge midway on the turn, quickly opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch and drew off with ease to win as her rider pleased. HAMSAs was taken in hand early, trailed along the backstretch, gained a bid inside the winner leaving the three-eighths pole, advanced three wide into the stretch, but was no match for the winner while much the best of the others. AWESOME I AM rushed up along the inside, set the pace along the backstretch, surrender the lead nearing the three-eighths pole, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. MEGA pressed the pace three wide for five furlongs, took the lead briefly on the far turn, relinquished the lead to the winner midway on the turn and drifted out while giving way in upper stretch. COUNTRY STAR flipped in the gate and was scratched by the stewards on the advice of the track veterinarian.
