GIROLAMO was well placed in midpack, moved up three wide to take the lead on the turn, shook loose in upper stretch and drew away under mild urging. EVEN RAISE was reserved for a half, split horses in upper stretch and finished willingly. EA was outrun to the turn then finished well between horses to gain a share. AMERICAN DANCE set the pace on the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. ADMIRALITY raced just off the pace between horses into upper stretch and lacked a late response. CAVE'S VALLEY failed to mount a serious rally. STUNGBYTHESTORM was well placed along the inside for six furlongs and lacked a further response. LOVE ABROAD never reached contention after breaking slowly. DON MISIL (ARG) pressed the pace on the rail and faltered on the turn.
