CHEECHAKO tucked along the rail soon after the start, was unhurried until about midway on the turn, found ample room and was taken into the two path splitting rivals in the process, all this occurring in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was given a couple of shots from the right side spinning into the lane along the outer edge of the three path and kicked into full gear, overhauled the pair of Darleys with a nice display of speed to be the clear leader by the eighth pole, edged away thereafter, crossing the wire under solid hand encouragement. LADY KIERKEGAARD outrun in the opening stages, was four wide and asked for run coming to the five-sixteenths pole, with the pilot applying several choppy right handed strokes near the right shoulder as motivation, displayed good energy down the middle of the strip to garner the place. HILDA'S LEGACY off the rail, was three wide for most of the way around the turn, got asked for a response by the midway point, finished well enough to be along for the show, although never posing a threat to the top twosome. CLOSING MOVE departed the backstretch three wide and being asked for some run, joined the front runners and made it a three way tussle from the three-eighths pole onward, spun into the stretch on nearly even terms with her entrymate, gave way in the final furlong. WELL RECEIVED assumed a forward position in the initial stages, pressed the issue two wide, was under some urging on the turn while keeping up the pressure, raced from between rivals for an eighth starting from the three-eighths pole, led the field into the stretch by a slim margin, got run down by the eventual winner a short distance from the furlong marker and faltered. LADY HALITE along the inside, argued to maintain control facing significant pressure from another pair during the second stage of the run around the bend, fell back several jumps before the quarter pole and tired. SWEET DIXIE BELLE took the inside route, nibbled on the bit proceeding down the backstretch with the rider atop with a snug grip on the reins, had that hold eased slightly and went about in a more relaxed fashion on the turn, was already under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, gave way.
