THOMAS HILL bumped with TWO SEVENTEEN after bobbling at the break, settled near the back of the pack in the early going in the two path, was put to mild hand urging and began to pick up the pace upon entering the turn, tipped into the three path midpoint, commenced the stretch four wide, closed in with good energy during the ensuing furlong to hitch up fully to the runner up, bested that rival as the duel continued, arriving at the sixteenth marker with the lead for good, kicked away, driving. DECISIVE MOVE away with no apparent mishap, disputed the pace from the outside, moved when ready and took over as the half was being completed, entered the stretch and got called upon, had the winner directly alongside and applying heavy pressure by midstretch, yielded before going another sixteenth, easily held on to place honors with no potential closers having ever arrived on the scene. JESS NOT JESSE chased three wide and gave way. STALLWALKIN' DUDE lightly coaxed to keep pace with the front runners sitting the pocket trip, was taken in hand when caught in some traffic late on the bend, found room to swing outward and did so, angling three wide into the stretch under urging, came up empty. SPIRAL STAIR saved ground for the initial half, got fanned outward at that juncture into the five path by the head of the stretch, made no impact. IMAGE OF DISCO four wide departing the backstretch, folded. TWO SEVENTEEN bobbed after making some contact with the winner at the start, raced along the outside, briefly between rivals at the top of the turn, tired. NEVER THE END argued for control for nearly a half, quit the fight once confronted in earnest by the second place finisher, tired and was eased in the stretch.
