Footnotes

BERNARDO away well, was taken in hand on the pace early on, got challenged and duled down the backside with PRIVATIZE to his inside, took over and inched away from the half mile pole still in hand, spun just off the inside for home, got shaken up straightened away and went clear kept to task to the end. PRIVATIZE bumped at the start, ranged up to challenge for command down the backside, got shaken off into the far turn and shifted to chase two to three wide, swung three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on mildly for the place. JACK'S R WILD just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and improved position by tired rivals for the show honors. JESSES GIANT DUNK shied out at the start and bumped with PRIVATIZE, raced three wide in aim of the front, came under a ride three furlongs from home, swung four wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. HERE HE FITZ three wide throughout, came under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole and offered no response. KING WANDO four wide in mid pack, got ridden along at the five-sixteenths, swung four to five wide at the quarter pole and made no impact. RYAN'S UTOPIA hit the near side stall at the start, was hustled away soon after, chased inside, was detached and last by midway and was eased midway on the turn.
