STREET SWAGG moved past a couple of rivals in the very earliest stages to grab the advantage, showed the way, being rated while at or near the inside for the opening three-quarters, turned for home under strong hand urging and drifted into the two path for the commencement of the stretch, lengthened away, kept to the task at hand. SUMMER PLACE TO BE chased the winner from off the inside, swung three wide into the stretch and proved no match. ALCOLITE tracked the top one while saving ground, faltered. JUNIOR OFFICER two wide and put to a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, failed to menace. EGO FRIENDLY in the three path and roused by the midway point on the turn, tired. EVERYDOGHASHISDAY saved ground until upper stretch to no avail.
