CUVEE pressed the pace from the outside while in hand, took over nearing the stretch, drew clear when asked and widened his margin under a drive. VALUE PLUS hit the gate at the start, was away slowly, dropped back early, rallied three wide on the turn, could not stay with the winner in the stretch but was well clear of the others. EL PRADO ROB was outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally while on the rail in the stretch. TABACCHI was rated along between rivals, raced four wide on the turn and had no response when roused. FLUSHING MEADOWS broke well, quickly showed in front, set the pace and tired after the opening three quarters. TUMBLEBRUTUS was rank at the post, came away awkwardly, dropped back along the inside and trailed.
