### Footnotes

HILLSWICK broke alertly and got engaged in a speed duel with SUN DANCE MOON almost from the get-go, raced on nearly even terms with that rival throughout the opening half, with the pilot of each mount doing his best to keep something in reserve for the stretch, was given his cue coming to the three-sixteenths, well after his fellow pace protagonist was asked for some run, struck the front about a sixteenth down the road, left the sixteenth pole a full length in front and continued to edge away, kept busy to the end. STARFORADAY off a beat slowly, dropped back in the initial stage, vacated the rail coming to the half mile pole, was urged on the turn to pick up the pace, rallied willingly enough to secure second. SUN DANCE MOON got hooked up in a protracted pace dispute with the eventual winner right from the start, went at it while travelling in the two path, was the first of the twosome to be asked for a response, doing so while spinning into the lane, weakened steadily during the last eighth. ELTISH STAR moved quickly to rail after the start, was the only member of the field to take the inside route around the turn, cut the corner under encouragement, lacked the needed response. SIX FLINGS off the inside, was coaxed along chasing a disputed pace, had no rally. MAD FOR SMARTY departed the backstretch three wide, sat within range of the ongoing duel, was through after completing a half.
