Footnotes

GLORY IN MOTION underwent a three to four wide journey, sat reserved in midpack for nearly three-quarters pole, began to pick up the pace coming to the end of the turn, spun from the four path in the stretch and was asked for a response, closed in well during the ensuing furlong, forged on ahead, departing the sixteenth pole with a clear advantage, edged away under good handling. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE left the chute and entered the backstretch three wide, contently bided time for the opening half, was placed four wide by the far turn, loosely drafted behind another opponent until nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came six wide into the stretch, got straightened away and commenced to rally in earnest, continued on with a good kick down the center of the course to garner place honors. STARJETTA came in slightly at the start, brushing with LOVELY PROMISE, moved up willingly to assume the role of stalker, was

rated keeping a watchful eye on the leader towards the two path, continued along on the same scenario until nearing the quarter pole, was asked for some run while issuing a challenge, fought her way to the front by the eighth pole, but with a dense pack of rivals still dangerously placed only a slight distance behind, gave in to the pressure soon afterwards and steadily weakened thereafter. SISTER BERTA made light contact with WISE CHOICE at the start, settled near the middle of the field in the two path, raced between rivals on the turn, was forced to be kept to a firm hold, lacking the needed racing room from midpoint until the quarter pole, was let out after turning for home, with some maneuverability now available, altered course just prior to the eighth pole for even better racing room and finished well to secure the last major award. READY TO PARTY three wide and between rivals on the turn, turned for home one path wider and rallied mildly to improve position. CHICK IN SLACKS well placed off the inside, angled three wide coming to the quarter pole, held well before flattening out in the last eighth. WISE CHOICE was bumped lightly at the start, ventured well to the middle of the course down the backstretch, but was back on the rail by the half mile pole, failed to reach a contending position. PROUD LISA placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the needed response. UNIQUE CITIZEN had a ground-saving journey, sat on hold after cutting the corner into the lane, hesitated before attempting to slip along the inside coming to the furlong marker, gained sufficient clearance, was put to encouragement, came up empty. LOVELY PROMISE brushed at the start, tracked the front runners from the inside for three-quarters and faltered. IT'S NOT FOR LOVE established control under her own power, tucked along the inside, showed the way rated until upper stretch, got overhauled and retreated.
