### Footnotes

ULTIMATE CLASS showed the way uncontested from just off the inside in the two path under a light hold through moderate fractions, cut the corner into the lane still on hold in stark contrast to those in behind, was set down at the three-sixteenths, widened away through the stretch kept busy to the line. SASSY'S DREAM coaxed from the start, settled under rating into the backside to track from along the inside, came under a drive just past the five-sixteenths, proved no match for the aforementioned rival, kept on under pressure to just preserve the place spot on the wire. PROUDROAD TO GLORY towards the rear saving ground, got spirited up at the three-eighths pole, spun three wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to just miss the place honors while garnering the show. TAKE HER TOTHE TOP three wide midpack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths to get more involved, swung five wide for home making steady progress, kicked home with good energy late on procuring the last major share while never threatening the top. TIGER GIRL rated in close range of the front from the three path, was pushed along at the five-sixteenths, remained a forward factor until the eighth pole before weakening late on. G. A. EMPRESS outrun in the early stages, saved ground at the rear until shifting out four to five wide straightening for home, passed tired foes late on while offering a mild bid. HEY BABE midpack just off the inside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide at the head of the lane and lacked a rally through the stretch. CENTRINA four deep just off the pace, came under coaxing at the midway point on the turn and offered no response.
