MADAM I'M ADAM broke slightly to the inside, went on to assume a forward position, argued for command while saving ground, got put to strong handling by the five-sixteenths marker, commenced the stretch run, nearer the two path than the rail, edged away from the runner up during the ensuing furlong put to some left handed stick work while doing so, drifted out several lanes leaving the sixteenth pole but held sway. SATURDAY APPEAL angled sharply over in the direction of the rail after the start, vied for command from the two path around the turn, was the second of the front runners to get asked for run, this occurring right at the quarter pole, fell back steadily while making his way through the furlong grounds, shied slightly outward as the errant winner was drifting to the outside in deep stretch, had to settle for being second best. FIERCE FACE bumped after the start, raced along the outside and proved no match for the top twosome. JEREK DETER was in the process of being maneuvered towards the inside when encountering a tightly-bunched grouping early down the backstretch, made very slight contact with the one directly alongside at the moment, departed the backstretch from the three path, had no kick. ALCOLITE broke to the outside but was pulled off the nearest opponent at the time to avoid making any contact, left the half mile pole, placed along the inside and fighting against the bit, faltered after leaving the furlong grounds. JUMP JOHNNY JIVE in the two path, was urged on the turn to no avail. RUN TO CLASS bumped a short distance out of the starting gate, lost some ground and momentum as a result of the occurrence, rode the rail, was already under solid encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to menace. UTOPIAN WISH got pinched back after bumped soon after the start, losing significant ground and momentum as a result, raced from off the inside and was outrun thereafter. THREE FOR TWO swung four wide into the stretch and had no rally.
