SCAM contently tracked the wayward runner up during the initial stages, ranged up after the first fraction had been recorded to hitch on to that opponent, raced side by side on even terms with the foe during the run around the bend, poked a head down in front as three-quarters was being completed and got asked for his best, gave it, kicking away to a comfortable margin. TIZ FOR TAT brushed with STREET SLANG as the field was sent on its way, shook free of the others, despite drifting outward in the early going, settled into the two path coming to the end of the backstretch, with the winner directly alongside at this juncture, raced as a team with foe until the quarter pole, got set down for the stretch but started to slowly but steadily lose contact, continued onward in fine fashion to be second best. KING OF BROADWAY settled into a forward position after the start, got tipped into the three path midpoint on the turn, challenged in earnest turning for home, lacked the needed response. TOWN EXTENSION broke slightly to the inside, leaning upon the nearest opponent, that being HOWIE'S TIZ, tucked along the rail and rode it for a majority of the opening six furlongs, was put to solid encouragement getting angled into the four path entering the stretch, flattened out. TONY D three wide and under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, made no impact. HOWIE'S TIZ bobbed at the start, was placed five wide at the head of the stretch, failed to menace. STREET SLANG brushed at the start, was let out a notch departing the backstretch, tired.
